
Mayor Riccio started the meeting off by bringing everyone up to speed on the DPW Garage situation at 90 College Avenue. It is not just the roof it's the condition in general. He thought we should get together to discuss this. Robert Rowe, Code Officer went down there to inspect it. The roof has many layers, the building is full of cracks. On a sunny day you can see daylight through the cracks. There is no fire safety, no CO's, the drainage is poor, it is just deplorable. Rain water is coming through the building. As the Code Officer, and if this was a private structure, Bob would condemn the building. We could put a new roof, but Bob said that the way the structure is, it may not hold it. We should have a structural engineer look at it. We need to have an immediate fix to move the employees, vehicles and the equipment, then we need to look at a long term solution. We will look at some options to move the employees out, such as a trailer or a temporary storage and then see what we can do to move the equipment. This building deteriorated long before the roof came off. This is not a good situation down there.
