Garage Use:

We are an emergency response agency, it is very difficult to respond to emergencies such as a fire, heart attack, Officer calling for assistance, etc. if the vehicles have ice and snow on them. It is the responsibility of **ALL** shifts and Officers to make sure the vehicles are kept in such a condition that they can readily respond to an emergency at any time.

We have room for two (2) vehicles in the garage, if two (2) patrol vehicles are out on patrol; put one of the other vehicles in the garage during inclement weather. If an Officer wishes to come in early, or stay late to wash their personal vehicle' complete your task, take a few minutes to drive it out, and then put a department vehicle back in the garage. No personal vehicles are to be kept in the garage for any length of time, especially during inclement weather.

Note: The vehicle equipped with the LPR (702) needs to be in the garage during inclement weather to reduce exposure damage.
